Fostering cooperation between Horizon Europe Cluster 5 National Contact Points (NCPs)

- 🏠 Targeting the entire Cluster 5 NCPs community, of which 19 EU member states and Associated countries are partners
- 🏠 Starting date 1st July 2022, end date 31st December 2027 (project duration of 66 months)
- 🏠 Overall objective
 - Improve the professionalisation and skills of Cluster 5 NCPs across Europe, simplifying applicant's access to Horizon Europe calls and raising the average quality of submitted proposals
- 🏠 Specific objectives
 - Raising the general standard of support to applicants
 - Raising applicants' awareness on Horizon Europe funding
 - Lowering the entry barriers for newcomers
 - Increasing the quality and inclusiveness of consortia
 - Forstering the visibility of the cluster 5 NCPs



Project structure based on three pillars

- ▮ NCPs capacity building and competence development
- ▮ Development of targeted and high-quality services for Cluster 5 applicants and stakeholders
- ▮ Cluster 5 community building and general mainstreaming of Cluster 5 NCPs in Horizon Europe

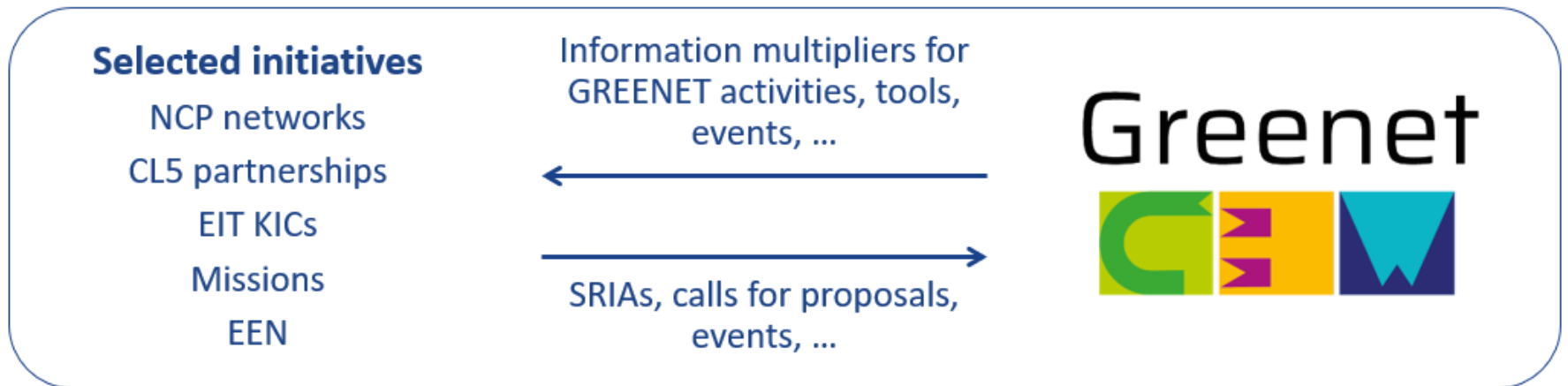
Communication and dissemination work package
