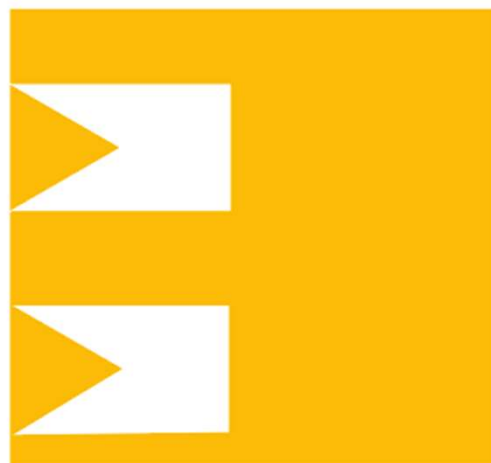
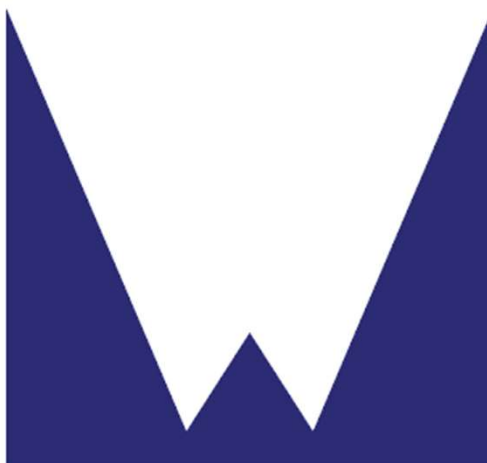

## What are Stakeholders?

There are many types of organisations that have an interest or 'stake' in the outcomes of the Horizon Europe Cluster 5: Climate, Energy and Mobility Work Programme. These include, but are not limited to:

- Horizon Europe Partnerships that have an immediate influence on the direction of the Work Programme through the strategic Research and Innovation Agendas (STRIAs) that their members develop
- European Technology and Innovation Platforms that are recognised by the European Commission as 'the voice' of innovators – business, academia and others – in their sector
- Regulatory and Standards bodies that need to update requirements in the light of new developments
- Collaborative networks of research and innovation communities that share knowledge to maximise impact and facilitate the implementation of new systems and solutions
- Industry associations that are keen to support their members to maintain European competitive advantage and be early adopters of novel technology



## Why do I need to know about Stakeholders?

Appropriate engagement with the relevant Stakeholders can greatly enhance the probability of success of proposals written for Horizon Europe competitions. Here are some of the ways knowing your stakeholders can help:

- Understand the background & the problem/issue behind the topic. This will help you to develop the most effective approach to resolving it
- Understand where the outputs of the project would be directed and so create an effective implementation pathway
- Network with others who are also interested in the same Topic and so find knowledgeable consortium partners with complementarity of skills and capabilities

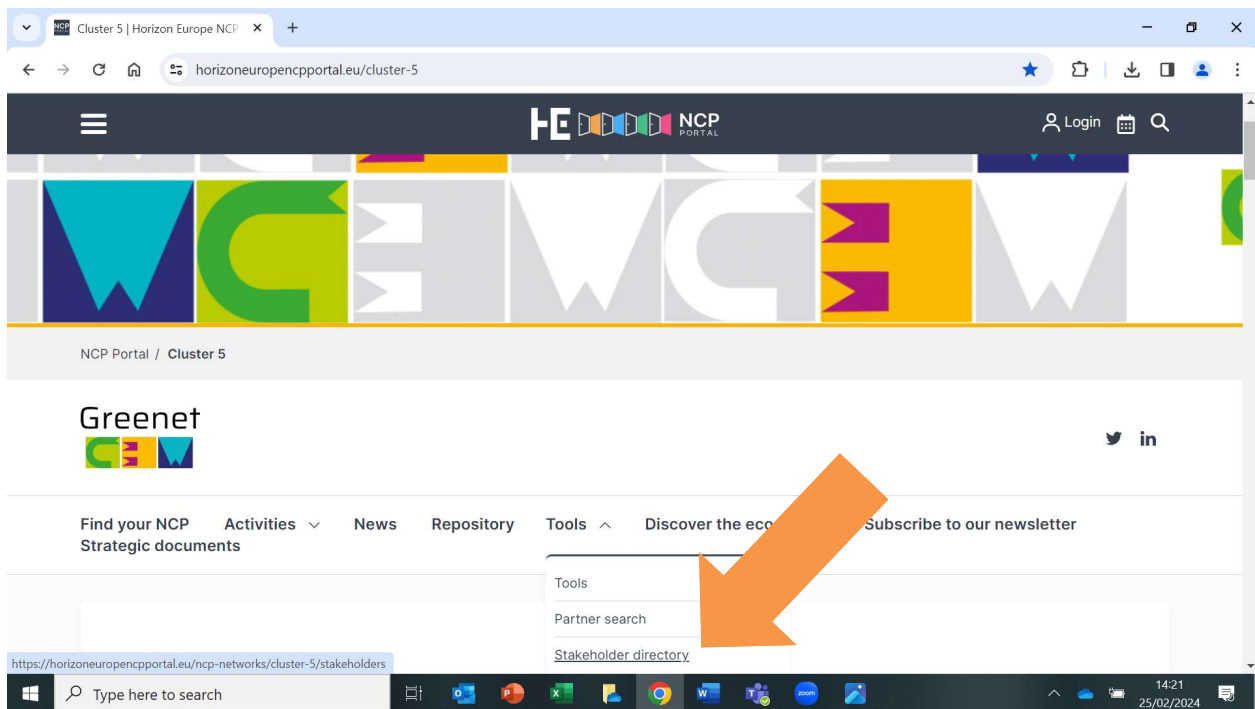

## Now I've found the right stakeholders, what should I do next?

Of course, this depends on why you wanted to find them but ALWAYS: introduce yourself and your organisation, describe your capabilities and what projects you have done previously and then:

- **To find potential consortium partners:** Tell them about projects you would like to do and what you see your organisation's role in those being. Ask about opportunities to meet (virtually or in-person) others with an interest in the same topics.
- **To have a say in the direction of the future Work Programme:** Ask about how you could contribute to the work of the partnership or technology platform, and how much membership would cost for an organisation like yours – fees often vary.
- **To better understand the underlying policy to a topic:** Consult the GREENET Document Repository to find the relevant policy papers that the organisation has published <https://horizoneuropencportal.eu/ncp-networks/cluster-5/european-cluster-5-document-repository>
