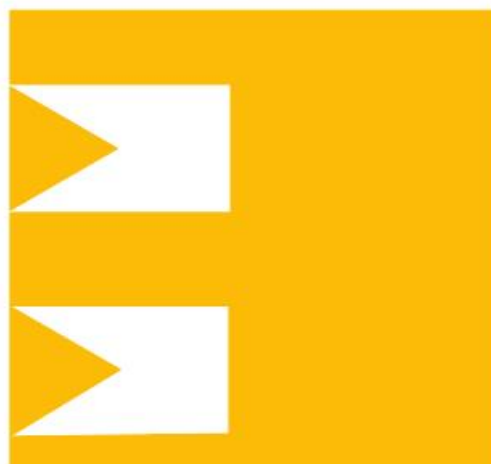

To contribute to the European Green Deal and support the achievement of the decarbonisation targets for 2030 and 2050, the **Connecting Europe Facility (CEF)** programme supports the development of high-performance, sustainable, and efficiently interconnected trans-European networks in transport, energy, and digital services through infrastructure investment.

## Objectives



The CEF aims at **accelerating investment in the field of trans-European networks** and at leveraging funding from both the public and the private sectors. The programme focuses on delivering **increased synergies and complementarity between transport, energy and digital sectors**. For that purpose, the CEF not only addresses the above-mentioned specific intervention areas, but also encourages synergetic elements

## CEF Energy

CEF Energy aims at the development of **sustainable and interconnected energy infrastructures** across Europe (Trans-European Networks for Energy - TEN-E ).

## Objectives



Contribute to the development of **projects of common interest** relating to further integration of an efficient and competitive internal energy market, interoperability of networks across borders and sectors, facilitating decarbonisation of the economy, promoting energy efficiency and ensuring security of supply

Facilitate **cross-border cooperation in the area of energy**, including renewable energy

## EU PROJECTS OF COMMON INTEREST (PCI)

Every two years the European Commission draws up a list of [EU projects of common interest \(PCI\)](#) that may apply for funding.

Since its start, CEF Energy has funded [149 actions](#) contributing to the improvement of 107 PCIs with a total financial support of €4.7 billion,

### Main PCI's topics:

Energy efficiency; Renewable energy; energy markets and consumers; energy strategy; Oil, gas and coal; energy infrastructure; energy security; low carbon and clean energy technologies; EU energy international cooperation; nuclear energy; energy system integration.

## CROSS-BORDER PROJECTS FOR RENEWABLE ENERGY

The CEF Energy programme for 2021-2027 includes a new category of eligible projects: [cross-border projects for renewable energy](#); which is specifically focused on cross-border cooperation to optimise national efforts for the deployment of renewable energy. More information [here](#).

## CEF Transport

CEF Transport is an EU- funding instrument striving for the development of **efficient, sustainable** and **interconnected trans-European transport networks** (TEN-T) and the improvement of already existing Eurotransport networks by **co-financing projects**.

## Objectives



- completion by 2030 of the Core Network, structured around [9 multimodal Core Network Corridors](#)
- completion by 2050 of the Comprehensive Network to facilitate accessibility to all European regions

## What for 2021-2027 period

**Total Budget** : €25.81 bn (of which 11bn reserved to the cohesion countries and 1.69 for military mobility)

### Particular focus on:

- the development of projects of common interest relating to efficient, interconnected and multimodal networks and infrastructure for smart, interoperable, sustainable, inclusive, accessible, safe, and secure mobility;
- adaptation of parts of the TEN-T for the dual use of the transport infrastructure



### Main topics of interest:

elimination of bottlenecks, strategies to fill missing links (improvement of cross-border sections); sustainable and efficient transport systems in the long term ( in relation to future transport flows); decarbonisation of all transport modes; optimisation of the integration and interconnection of transport modes; improvement of the interoperability of transport services and ensuring the accessibility of transport infrastructure.
