

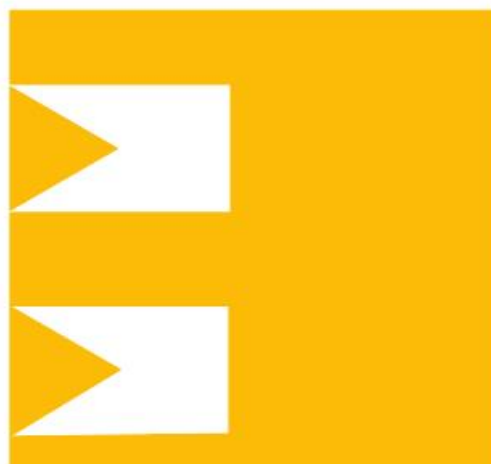

The Co-Programmed Partnership on People-centric sustainable built environment – B4P - aims to catalyse the transition to a people-centric, climate-neutral, sustainable and smart built environment

## Objectives

During the seven years of the Horizon Europe Framework Programme, the B4P Partnership plans to channel about € 380 million EU funding to sector innovation, together with equivalent sum from private sector.



The three General Objectives are:

- **Scientific** – to generate holistic innovation towards sustainability.
- **Economic** - to revitalise the sector through decarbonisation and sustainability transition.
- **Societal** – to induce lasting behavioural change towards sustainable living

## Funding opportunities

There are 7 specific objectives addressed in the strategic research and innovation agenda:

- A. Develop holistic solutions in a systemic approach
- B. Demonstrate overall performance in the life-cycle perspective
- C. Demonstrate clean energy transition potential
- D. Demonstrate sector decarbonisation pathways
- E. Demonstrate sustainable, circular business and value chain
- F. . Demonstrate affordability and cost-effectiveness
- G. Demonstrate no trade-offs on economy, comfort, health, functions, cultural heritage
