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

The basics of the consortium



IA & RIA: min. 3 independent legal entities

- > at least 1 established in a MS;
- > at least 2 other independent legal entities, each established in different MS or AC.

Check: - H.E. General annexes, section B

- additional conditions at topic level

What the right number is will depend on the **requirements** of the project topic, the **expected outcomes/impacts**, the **activities** proposed and the available **budget**.

Complementarity

- Avoid redundance
- Each partner a unique role



Shared vision

Agreement on overall goals of the project



Strong leadership

- Skills (admin, financial, topic...)
- Experience & network



Trust

- Quality of relationships
- Fostering quality of actions

- Profiles / types of partners



Agility

 Need for flexibility in case of change

Leading a new consortium or joining an existing one: Tips on how to make your decision

- ➤ Are you **comfortable** acting as a leader?
- Are you ready to be the intermediary between the EC and the beneficiaries?
- Can you manage admin/reporting work?
- Can you take care of budgeting and financial checks?
- Can you handle the communication needs of a consortium?
- Do you have the capacity to arrange all necessary meetings and events?
- > Do you have the necessary **HR resources** (1 FTE)? If not, can you hire 1 FTE?

If you answer 'yes' to all these questions, you are prepared to lead a new consortium

If you answer 'no' to one or more questions, perhaps you should rather join an existing
consortium



3) How

Steps to build your consortium

1. Have a clear view on the profiles needed



Functions planning (set of requirements / roles in the project)

2. Build core consortium



Gather high excellence / key opinion leaders within the specific field and establish a core consortium

3. Develop the innovative idea



Together with this core consortium: draft the scope, main objectives and rough outline of the project idea

4. Bring in the rest of the partners



Start building the rest of the consortium from this core



Tips

- Build your **network** and give **visibility** to your organization
 - **Explore** networks of colleagues and partners
 - Attend events: matchmaking / networking events, seminars, sectoral events
 - Use the pitching sessions offered during some events
 - Social Media: LinkedIn
 - Participate in networking projects (e.g. COST actions <u>www.cost.eu/cost-actions</u>)
- Work with those you know and trust
- Build on existing partnerships, but do not rely on them
- Check the Model Consortium Agreement (<u>DESCA</u>) > incl. NDA question





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

In general, the following basic services are available in accordance with the **NCP Guiding Principles** 2 agreed by all countries:

- 1. Guidance on choosing relevant Horizon Europe topics and types of action
- 2. Advice on administrative procedures and contractual issues
- 3. Training and assistance on proposal writing
- 4. Distribution of documentation (forms, guidelines, manuals etc.)
- 5. Assistance in partner search

As the NCPs are national structures, the type and level of services offered may differ from country to country.

Brokerage events - high quality profile!

It is extremely important to dedicate the necessary attention to detailing the profile: the better the quality of the profile, the better the quality (and number) of meeting requests, besides the chances of signing contacts!

To ensure that your profile can be validated right away by enabling you to explore the participants' profiles and ask for meetings, <u>be sure to</u>:

- ✓ To include your contacts
- ✓ To provide a short but effective description of your organisation (max. 1000 characters is recommended), highlighting its relevance for the *Topics* of your interest and the Project Cooperation offer that you have drafted.
- ✓ To provide at least 1 Project Cooperation offer, possibly including:
- o A title focusing on what you are searching or offering
- o A short description of the idea for cooperation and the eventual department/Unit that is responsible for it
- A section "What we offer/what we are looking for", including if your organisation is looking for partners as a Coordinator of a potential project proposal, or it's just offering expertise as a potential Partner
- Always tick at least 1 relevant Topic or other available fields for matchmaking: this will help the other registered participants to find you and ask for bilateral meetings.

There is no second chance to make a first impression!

Brokerage event – profile and meeting

- Clear request: potential Coordinator or Partner?
- Present your innovative idea (problem you solve, product/service/other offered).
- Describe eventually the reference Market, and the market dimension
- TRL level (show clearly the features of your solution).
- Value proposition based on experimental data, prototype development, reflecting expected performance of the technology.
- Advantages of your solution respect to the competitors (competitive advantage?)
- Intellectual Property (IP strategy?)
- Present your team as the right team/company to achieve the result
- NO SENSITIVE AND/OR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION!

Pitching session



- = opportunity to present your organisations and ideas and/or expertise
- Make a list of things you want to say, at least:
 - The **topic**(s) you are interested in
 - The **objectives** of your proposal for a project idea
 - Your and/or your organisation expertise in relation to the topic(s)
 - Idea of the existing partnerships / requirements for additional partner(s)
 - Experience: involvement in previous/ongoing projects in the area
- Check the consistency of the information you will present.
- Practice your presentation as much as possible to fit the timing and avoid reading.






Green Days, International business meetings
