One major theme? **Affordable housing**—not just as a roof over your head, but as a cornerstone of democratic participation. Because when people have a say in where and how they live, good things tend to follow.

- Show off your NEB-aligned project Apply for the Fair (Deadline: 30 September 2025)
- Bring your art, music, or cultural spark Apply for the Fest (Deadline: 30 September 2025)
- Host a Satellite Event Anywhere in Europe or beyond (Deadline: 31 December 2025)

Let's co-create a Festival that's as inspiring as it is grounded. Bring your ideas, your energy, and maybe a few extra chairs—we're expecting a crowd.

- Bio-fabricated materials for sustainable and beautiful construction
- Beautiful, sustainable and inclusive street furniture for the transformation of neighbourhoods
- Reverse local construction supply chains for the beautiful re-assembly of reclaimed construction products
- The impact of common space on neighbourhood communities

- <u>Fostering and maintaining the social fabric for the green transition in neighbourhoods</u>
- Innovative approaches for sustainable, inclusive and beautiful social and affordable housing
- Renovating the built environment through design for adaptability and disassembly.
