- European network of National Contact Points (NCPs) for Cluster 5 “Climate, Energy and Mobility
- Funded by the European Commission under the Horizon Europe Framework Programme for Research and Innovation.
- Launched on the 1<sup>st</sup> Jul. 2022 - Closing on 31<sup>st</sup> Dec. 2027



The network of National Contact Points (NCPs) is the main structure to provide guidance, practical information and assistance on all aspects of participation in Horizon Europe. NCPs are also established in many non-EU and non-associated countries ("third countries").

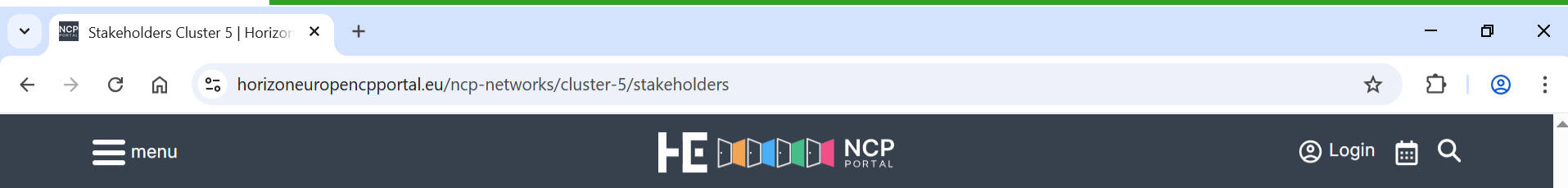
